Methods of Measuring Outcomes

- 1. Evaluation of results: After each semester we evaluate the results in order to get an idea how a course is developing their abilities of critical thinking and individual evaluation of issues.
- 2. Other forms of tests: Class tests, project submissions, debates etc determine outcomes of specific course study.
- 3. Analysis of assignments designed to test conceptual understanding: Students are given assignments (Projects, class presentations, essay writing etc.) for our understanding of how they are being capable of getting in depth ideas of a subject in specific course.
- 4. Graduation Rates: We evaluate the number of students who graduate after finishing the courses we offer: General and Honours. This helps in measuring an outcome of the courses taught.
- 5. Admission to advance course: We track the future projects of pass out students. The admission to higher studies of our students determines an outcome.
- 6. Survey of alumni: Alumni survey enables us to trace their progress in various fields (higher study, employment etc.) after they complete the study of specific courses.
- 7. Observations of student's performance: Performance in both academic and cultural events helps us to evaluate their progress and derive an outcome.
- 8. Analysis of their ability to independent thinking: Study of academic courses, specially courses in social sciences increase their ability to think critically. We observe our student's activities through projects and problems in order to evaluate their growing ability to think independently. This helps in structuring a course outcome for us.
- 9. Analysis of students' involvement in research projects: Academic courses in U.G programme pave the way for students to research in various fields. We evaluate the number of students that go into research projects which determine the outcome of the academic course we offer.
- 10. Evaluation of quality and quantity: In determining the course outcomes we need to measure both qualitative and quantitative data. We evaluate both the quality of the projects they go into, jobs they get and also the number of students who strive any form of higher pursuit. These assessments help us to arrive at conclusions regarding outcome of the course we undertake.
