Agenda 1. Read and confirm the resolutions of the last meeting

Coordinator read out the resolution of IQAC Meeting dated 23.12.2021. It was unanimously accepted.

Agenda 2.Psychological Counselling for students

Coordinator stressed the need for psychological counselling due to increased stress among students during the pandemic.

It was resolved that **Student Welfare Subcommittee** would make necessary arrangement for monthly visit of a **psychological counsellor** in the institution.

It was also resolved that **Student Mentors** will be actively involved in the process.

Agenda 3. Introduction of skill-building, career development and self-improvement courses for students.

Coordinator described the need for skill-building, career development and self-improvement value added courses for students of this college in the present socio-economic condition.

It was resolved that

West Bengal Comprehensive Area Development Corporation (WBCADC) and other such Government Institutions / Departments would be approached for the list of courses that may be introduced in our institution as value added courses. The course duration should be of at least 30 hrs. and the course would be held outside the class routine.

Following courses were specifically discussed for introduction in near future:

- a) Poly-tank fish culture
- b) Imitation jewellery and fashion-ware making
- c) Horticulture and mangrove tree plantation

Agenda 4. Miscellaneous

a) Infrastructural support for students enrolled in NPTEL value added courses:

IQAC coordinator informed that 17 students of our institution have enrolled in different value added courses during this semester in the recently introduced NPTEL platform. It was resolved that concerned departments would provide infrastructural support, study materials and other help to students who have enrolled in different NPTEL courses.

b) Review of quality measures taken by IQAC during the last four meetings:

Coordinator informed that some resolved quality initiatives of previous IQAC meetings are yet to be implemented.

It was resolved that administration, concerned departments and subcommittees would implement the resolved quality initiatives at the earliest.

c) Continuation of blended mode of teaching during the ensuing semester (January-July, Session 21-22)

It was resolved that in order to complete the syllabus in reduced time during the ensuing semester teachers may take classes in blended mode (both in person and online) according to their convenience as and when required.
